



SNAPSHOT

In calendar year 2020, GoochlandCares provided services to over 2,518 Goochland residents in need. Those services are supported by 500+ volunteers.

ELIGIBILITY:

To receive services, clients must be 18 years old, reside in Goochland**, and meet the following income requirements:

2021 GoochlandCares Income Requirements (income = gross annual)

For ALL SERVICES including the Free Clinic:

- Individual \$25,760 or less
- Household of 2 \$34,840 or less
- Household of 3 \$43,920 or less
- Household of 4 \$53,000 or less

For non-Clinic services (like Food Pantry and Clothes Closet - does not include Medical, Mental Health, or Dental Care):

- Individual \$25,760 or less
- Household of 2 \$34,840 or less
- Household of 3 \$43,920 or less
- Household of 4 \$53,000 or less

For Medical Care only (does not include Dental Care or Mental Health Care) (**You may reside in Goochland, Louisa, Fluvanna, or Cumberland):

- Individual \$38,640 or less
- Household of 2 \$52,260 or less
- Household of 3 \$65,880 or less
- Household of 4 \$79,500 or less

Twelve critical assistance programs allow GoochlandCares to respond to each individual's or family's specific needs:

HISTORY:

Goochland Fellowship and Family Services was founded in 1952. The Free Clinic of Goochland was started in 2000. In 2007, the groups merged and incorporated as Goochland Free Clinic and Family Services. In 2018, the name was officially changed to GoochlandCares.

LOCATION:

GoochlandCares operates out of a new, 20,000 square-foot facility at 2999 River Road West in the Goochland Courthouse area. Also on site is a brick triplex used for emergency housing.
